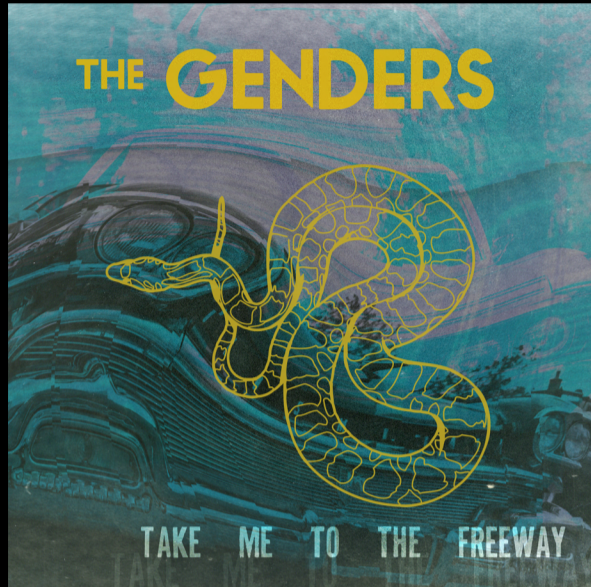

Bio:

The Genders were formed in 2004 in Tel Aviv, Israel. They recorded their first album "Rockin in Ramallah" (AMP Records/8th Note Records) and in 2005 went on their first US tour. In 2006 The Genders released "Virgin No. 72" (Dead Seas Records) and embarked on an extensive US tour that took them from coast to coast and back again twice (!), solidifying their status as Israel's hardest working rock band.

In 2013, The Genders completed their 3rd album, "Guts and Heartstrings" (Dead Sea Records). The album was released in June 2013 to rave reviews; Classic Rock Magazine's Ken McIntyre hails it a "headfirst dive towards Golden Gods status".

The Genders' music has been featured on the following TV series and movies:

"90210", "Castle", "Combat Nurses", "Plain Jane", "LA Ink", "Rizolli and Isles", "American Pie 7 - The Book of Love", "That's My Boy" (starring Adam Sandler), "Future Weather", "Hung", "Justified", "True Blood", "The Affair", "The Good Wife", "I Smile Back" (starring Sarah Silverman), "Mayans", "Wynonna Earp" and many more.

In 2017 The Genders relocated to Austin, Texas, and with a brand new lineup featuring Israeli, Iranian and American musicians, record "Take Me To The Freeway", their 4th studio album. Released in 2019, the album features a return to a classic 60's rock'n'roll tone, featuring the ballad "Happiness (Don't Live Here No More)", which has become a local Austin hit.
